The Deenabandhu Charitable Trust was formally set up on 4th July 1996 with the purpose of helping the poor and needy who come to Mysore for medical treatment and find it difficult to continue it due to lack of funds. There are also cases of accident victims who need emergency assistance before their relatives arrive to help them.

An appeal was sent out to many of our well-wishers, including some abroad, for generous contributions. It is heartening to note the wonderful response to this noble cause. In a short span of just six months the Trust has been able to collect a sum of a little over rupees one lakh which has since been placed in fixed deposit.

Since a general advertisement in the papers regarding the assistance available from the Trust may bring in a spate of requests, which the Trust may not be able to honour at present, it has been decided to inform the donors that from July '97 when interest from FDs start coming in we will be able to render help in a small way to begin with.
