It has been 14 years since Deenabandhu Charitable Trust came into being. During these years the Trust has been financially helping about 25 to 30 students of the Kodava Community every year to pursue their studies. Of these a boy and a girl have become Engineering graduates. After they started earning both of them Ammanakuttanda Jeeth Bopaiah and Thambanda Hansey Ganesh have gratefully returned the financial help they received from us. One more of our beneficiaries has got married this year. Deenabandhu Trust paid her mother Rs. 5,000/- so as to help her meet the marriage expenses.

Unfortunately, Chaya who cannot speak or hear has not been able to cope up with her studies in the Diploma Course in Computer Applications for the visually impaired. As a very special case, we have decided to pay Chaya Rs. 5,000/- to help her continue her studies this year also.

Both Maya (name changed) who last year gave up her engineering college seat in Ponnampet because she could not get a bank loan and her brother are doing very well in B.Sc. Computer Science. We are very happy with their progress. We have been paying them Rs. 5,000/- each for the last 4 years. With Mr. P.S. Ganapathy and Mr. K.A. Kariappa's help the Trust got a job for their mother without which they would have found it much more difficult to make both ends meet.

Chammattira Rikhi Somaiah met with a freak accident just a few months before her final examination in which she lost an entire leg. Her unemployed father had to spend a fortune for her treatment. Inspite of her being in bed for more than 4 months before her exams, she obtained a very high first class in Class X. The Trust not only paid Rs. 5,000/- for her freatment but has also selected her for PULIANDA A. DEVAYA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (which is being administered by D.B. Trust) for 2009 and awarded her Rs. 10,000/- to encourage her in her studies. She is considered the best student of the year among our beneficiaries. Dr. Adengada A. Kuttappa who was a special invitee in one of our meetings has offered to help Rikhi in replacing her Jaipur Foot as and when it becomes necessary.

This year we have so far distributed Rs. 1,00,000/- among parents of 23 Kodava Students (13 girls and 10 boys) studying in different schools and colleges of Mysore, Gonikoppa, Virajpet, Madikeri, Kushalnagar and Bangalore. Prof. Ittira K. Biddappa, Principal, Cauvery College, Virajpet was very helpful in identifying three very poor students of his college who needed financial help. we have paid them Rs. 5,000/- each. We are thankful to him for showing interest in our work. During the period under this report we also paid Rs. 5,000/- each to two accident victims and four cancer patients - one of whom is an Ammakodava.

Mr. Chendrimada Mohit Thimmalah - a young engineer in Singapore - has created a website for the Deenabandhu Charitable Trust. This can be visited at kodavadeenabandhu.org Mohit apart from donating Fis. 5,000/- every year for the last 3 years has also carried our message to the Kodava get-together in Singapore. Mrs. and Col. (Rtd.) Napaneravanda B. Belliappa are continuing to help one girl student by getting her College fee reduced and also by paying part of the balance amount directly.

REORGANISATION

Since the inception of the Trust in 1996, Col. (Rtd.) Pattamada C. Ganapathy has been its President and was its tower of strength. Because of his advancing age and indifferent health, he has expressed a desire to retire from the Trust and its Presidentship. In defference to his wishes and also as a step towards passing on the management of the Trust to the younger generation as proposed by Col. (Rtd.) P.C. Ganapathy himself in a meeting of the trust held on 3.8.2009, Mr. Maletira M. Kaveriappa, the Secretary of the Trust was unanimously appointed as its President. One of our special invitees of that day Mr. Kokkengada C. Karumbaiah - a leading advocate of Mysore who has been taking a lot of interest in our activities - was invited to be a trustee in the place vacated by Col. (Rtd.) P.C. Ganapathy, Wg. Cdr. (Rtd.) C.G. Madappa opted to continue as the Treasurer of the Trust.

More and more Kodavas are coming forward to help us meet our financial needs and augment our resources. Mr. Biddanda Dulip Nachalah from Quatar who last year along with his son Mr. Arjun in USA had given Rs. 30,000/- this year sent us a donation of Rs. 40,000/-
