Deenabandhu Charitable Trust, Mysore was started in the year 1996 by the initiative of Late Mrs Maletira M Chittiana along with Late Pattamada Col (Rtd) Ganapathy, Maj Gen (Rtd) Codanda K Karumbaya, Late Mr Maletira M Kaveriappa, Col (Rtd) Napaneravanda Belliappa, Late Mr Pulianda A Devaya, Mr Maletira M Nanjappa and registered as a Trust in the year 1997. Since then, more and more philanthropic Kodavas have been contributing their might to our Trust and are encouraging us to help in the education of poor Kodava children. They also contribute in meeting the medical expenses of some of the less fortunate members of our community suffering from severe ailments. It was with their help and never failing encouragement that this Trust was built.

Unfortunately, Mr Maletira M Kaveriappa who was the Secretary of the Trust since its inception & its President since Aug'09 passed away on 01 Oct '13. His devotion to the cause & his unflagging efforts have brought succor to many poor Kodavas. In recognition of his work, he was honoured by the Kodava Samaja, Mysore, Kodava Samaja Madikeri & the Field Marshal K M Cariappa & Gen K S Thimayya Forum. In his death, the Trust has lost a tireless worker & an ardent supporter of the cause.

During the period under this report two more of our kind hearted donors Air Commodore Balyanda Appachoo and Mr Nayakanda Chengappa passed away. We pray that their souls may rest in peace.

This year, in addition to the 24 Donors mentioned in our earlier News Letter, 5 more large hearted Kodavas have given us Rs One Lakh and more, asking us to institute Scholarships in the names of their near and dear ones. Accordingly, this year we have awarded 29 special scholarships of Rs 10,000/- each to the following students.

Apart from the above we have also awarded Rs 5000/-each to 33 students and Rs 3000/-each to 9 students. It is noteworthy to mention that the Beneficiaries of the Trust included two Ammakodavas and two yerava students. For want of space we have not listed them in this Newsletter.

As during the previous years, Prof I K Biddappa of Sai Shankar Educational Institutions, Ponnampet, Dr A S Poovamma Principal, Cauvery college, Virajpet, Mrs Ittira kamalakshi Biddappa HOD, Cauvery college Gonikoppa and Principals and Heads of Institutions of schools and colleges in Virajpet, Gonikoppa, Ponnampet, Srimangala, Chichmundoor, Balele, Margodu, Mysore, Bangalore and few other places in the State have been of immense help in identifying the poor students who need help in their Institutions.

This year we have also distributed a total of Rs 62,000/-among 7 patients and accident victims. This includes Mr Ichanda Ponnappa who has been suffering from Cancer and Diabetes for the last several years and both of his legs have been amputated. Our Trust has been helping him in his treatment and his children in their education and marriage. This year we have given him 12 postdated cheques of Rs 1000/- each as pension which he can en-cash every month.
