Deenabandhu Charitable Trust (R), Mysore is a registered charitable organization based in Mysore. With the help of donations from Kodava philanthropists and philanthropic organisations, the Trust is able to reach out to the very poor people of Kodagu and lend a helping hand at educating their children. The Trust also contributes to meet the expenses of less fortunate Kodavas, suffering from severe ailments. The money collected from donors is kept as FDs and the interest accrued is distributed to the needy, every year.

The Trust was started in the year 1996 and registered in the year 1997, an initiative of Late Mrs. Maletira M Chittiana and her friends with Late Col (Rtd) Pattamada Ganapathy as President. Subsequently Late Mr Maletira M Kaveriappa took over as President from year 2009 till he passed away on 01 Oct2013. During his tenure, the Trust's activities leapfrogged to help 71 students and seven patients in 2013.

This year, we are proud to mention that the Trust has helped 190 needy Kodava children, two Ammakodava and two Yerava students spanning Soorlabbi to Shrimangala. The total amount distributed is Rs 12,94,000/-. That includes 11 children for medical reasons. The Trustees have interacted with almost all the recipients and tried to motivate them to do well in their studies. The Trust has also extended financial help to 6 patients and accident victims. The total amount distributed is Rs 57,000/- till date.

It is heartening to mention that 92 philanthropic Kodavas have contributed their might and supported our Trust, this year. 14 among them have contributed Rs One Lakh each and more asking us to institute Scholarships in the names of their near and dear ones. Till date we have instituted a total of 50 special scholarships of Rs 10,000/-each, this year. In addition to these scholarships 48 children have received Rs 8,000/- each, 34 students have received Rs 5,000/- each, 54 students have received Rs 4000/-each and 8 students have received Rs 3000/-each. The recipients include 14 orphans, 42 children of single parents, 14 children of ailing parents, 4 children who require regular medical support and 76 BPL card holders. Academically, 1 is appearing for IAS, 10 are pursuing Masters, 1 MBBS, 8 Engg , 1 Diploma, 1 BPEd , 93 under graduates, 66 PUC and 13 are in school .

During the period under this report, two of our kind hearted donors Ballaranda Keshu Achaiah and Kodandera Mrs. Ganga Muthanna passed away. We pray for their souls to rest in peace.
